Applicants for the AVP/Mark Palmer CVA Scholarship must meet the following eligibility requirements:

For CCVA

- Minimum of the equivalent of three years of full-time experience related to volunteer resources management. *This experience can be a combination of several part-time positions and can include both salaried and non-salaried roles.*
- Minimum of 30 percent of current position related to volunteer resources management.
- Two letters of professional recommendation from supervisors or colleagues, verifying the applicant's appropriateness as a candidate.

For AVP

- Active, paid membership at time of application
- Maintain AVP Membership until completion of CVA credential

Submission Deadline to AVP = August 20th.

Registration Submissions accepted by CCVA from Oct. 1st—March 1st every cycle.

Late Fess may apply @ Dec. 31st.
